

COURSE PLAY AND RULES

JONES COURSE, SCRAMBLE

SPONSORED BY

Format: Scramble

RULES:

Tees: Men play from the Blue; Women from the Red.

1. Everybody drives.
2. Team selects which drive to play from.
3. From within one club length, no nearer the hole, and no improvement of lie (can't go from rough to fairway or trap to rough even if within one club length) everyone then plays the next shot from the selected spot. (Putts may not be moved.)
4. Continue selecting the best shot and playing from that spot until the hole is completed.
5. The ball must be putted into the hole. NO Gimmies.
6. Minimum of two drives for every golfer must be used.

NICKLAUS COURSE, MODIFIED SCRAMBLE

Format: Modified Scramble

Select Best Drive and play your own ball from there

RULES:

Tees: Men play from the Blue; Women from the Red.

1. Everybody drives.
2. Team selects which drive to play from.
3. From within one club length, no nearer the hole, and no improvement of lie (can't go from rough to fairway or trap to rough even if within one club length) everyone then plays their own ball into the hole. (Putts may not be moved.)
4. For the one score taken, the ball must be putted into the hole. NO Gimmies.
5. Minimum of two drives for every golfer must be used.
6. Only 1 Score per hole is needed. If you are out of a hole - please pick up.

SCORING:

1. Players use 50% of their handicap. 36 is the maximum handicap, therefore in this format 18 strokes is the most allowed.
2. Round down to the nearest number. i.e. a 17 handicap would get 8 strokes.
3. The scorecard shows the "handicap" ranking for each hole - 1 is the hardest hole and 18 is the easiest. If you are playing to a 16 handicap and getting 8 strokes you would deduct one stroke from your score on handicap holes 1 through 8 - that is your individual net score on the hole.
4. The one best net score is taken as the team score on the hole.

WAVERLY OAKS, ONE BEST BALL

Format: One Best Ball (Gross) - Play your own ball



STATE STREET.

RULES:

1. Everyone plays their own ball.
2. Play the ball down unless advised otherwise.
3. The one best score is taken as the team score on the hole.
4. For the one score taken, the ball must be putted into the hole. NO Gimmies.
5. Minimum - each golfer must have their score on a hole used at least once.
6. Only 1 Score per hole needed. If you are out of a hole - please pick up.
